
Pod people open homes

A POD-LIKE “city of the future” has opened its doors to the public.

The exploration of future living invited the public in as part of a contemporary arts event.

Geodecity, has seen people build and live in pod houses erected at Scraftoft Hill Farm, on the outskirts of the city, over the past 18 months.

Organisers from Reactor, of Nottingham, have used the experiment to look at how people could think about alternative ways of living.

About a dozen Geodecians gave the public a chance to view their idea of a future city.
